Spiritual

Our spiritual programme includes engaging RE lessons using a ‘mirrors and windows’ approach to explore beliefs and cultures. Pupils participate in Votes for Schools debates, experience assemblies with Reverend Emily, and take part in religious celebrations and festivals. Visits and visitors further enrich their understanding and respect for diverse faiths.

Social

Our social programme supports positive relationships and community through a clear behaviour policy and class charters. Pupils benefit from our social mentor, intervention and friendship groups, and engaging PSHE lessons. Lunchtime clubs, Cadmus activities, and the Amazing People Schools programme further promote teamwork, empathy, and social skills.

Moral

Our moral programme encourages pupils to develop a strong sense of right and wrong through discussions such as Votes for Schools debates and clear behaviour expectations supported by school values and rules. We use a restorative approach to behaviour and deliver the One Decision PSHE programme to build decision-making skills. Pupils also engage with Youthquake activities to promote social responsibility and ethical awareness.

Cultural

Our cultural programme celebrates diversity through RE lessons using a ‘mirrors and windows’ approach, exposing pupils to texts from a wide range of cultures. Pupils engage in events such as UK Parliament Week, Black History Month, Remembrance, and Chinese New Year, reflecting the rich variety of cultures within our school community.
